ZONES

- ZONE 1: ENTRY AND AMENITIES ZONE
- ZONE 2: STRUCTURED ACTIVITY
- ZONE 3A: QUIET AREA / PINE FOREST WALK
- ZONE 3B: QUIET RETREAT AREA

OFF LEASH AREA CONCEPT ITEMS

- 1

NEW FENCING AT ENTRY  
Fence to direct visitors down the main pathway into the off leash area. Fence to help control foot traffic through the mature trees and create a barrier to protect dogs from the carpark
- 2

SHADY TREE GROVE  
Plantings of shade trees with large scattered 'perch' rocks for informal seating beneath trees
- 3

PINE TREE STUMP CARVED SCULPTURES  
Retain up to 5 trunks and underplant with low level vegetation and mulch
- 4

DRY CREEK BED  
With rocks and logs to scramble over
- 5

2 x DOG BOWL DRINKER WITH TAP ON CONCRETE PAD  
Pad to be shaped with a shallow depression for water to pool before draining into surrounding area. Min 3m radius
- 6

QUIET AREA / ZONE 3B  
Remove scrubby bushes and small trees and plant a mix of native and exotic shade trees
- 7

DECOMPOSED GRANITE OR TOPPINGS PATHWAY - MAIN AREA  
1.5m wide, no edging
- 8

ROCK CLAMBER MOUND  
Consisting of large rocks. Mound to be approximately 1.5m high
- 9

DIGGING PATCH - MIN 400mm DEPTH  
Clean washed sand
- 10

DOG EDUCATION ELEMENTS  
On granitic sand surface, scattered along main pathway
- 11

GRAVEL PAD FOR COFEE VAN
- 12

SIT / STAY PLATFORMS  
Platforms only on concrete pads within grassed area - 2 sets shown


5 x 5m SKILLION SHELTER ON CONCRETE PAD  
Bench seating around perimeter on 2 sides. No picnic tables to deter bringing of food into off leash area
- 14

QUIET AREA / ZONE 3A  
Native tree plantings throughout, pruned up to maintain viewlines and aid ease of maintenance
- 15

SECONDARY GRANITIC PATHWAY  
Utilise existing desire lines / goat tracks where possible
- 16

UPGRADE PERIMETER FENCING  
Utilising existing fence posts, install farm mesh (dog proof) fencing perimeter of site bordering off leash area
